## ARLIS/NA Central Plains Fall 2017 Chapter Meeting

Co-Hosted by the Kansas City Art Institute and The Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art Held at The Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art, Kansas City October 20, 2017

The University of Illinois, Urbana, is accepting chapter archives of enduring research value. Columbia University is scanning chapter websites hosted from ARLIS/NA.
