Bebb was known for his multiplate soft-ground and aquatint etchings. He resided in Muskogee, Oklahoma, and was a noted member of several print societies, including the Prairie Print Makers.

3:30 to 5:00: *Collectible World Beads: Trade, Crafts and Cultures on a String* presented by Kathy Richardson, co-owner of Small World Gallery in Lindsborg and founder of IBISwoman Jewelry Design. Bead history appeals to the scientist, geographer, craftsman, sociologist, economist and trader in everyone. Kathy will cover the earliest modes of personal ornament and money in shells beads and forward to the late 20th century rebirth of Eastern European cottage methods of bead making. She will include photographs and stories of beads from her own collection of glass, stone, ceramics and metals. She has also promised to focus on resource materials related to bead history.

6:30 p.m.: Dinner at the Renaissance Café in Assaria, KS. The restaurant is located in an old school building at 210 N. Center Street in Assaria. It features a Northern Italian inspired menu.
