Discovering Historic and Artistic Sedalia, Missouri

Please join us to discover the small town of Sedalia, Missouri, located in west central Missouri at the junction of U. S. Highways 65 and 50. Sedalia is a historic town that grew to prominence when it was the railhead for the Sedalia/Shawnee cattle drives of the 19th century. Major “shops” of the M-K-T and Missouri Pacific railroads made it a rail center. Scott Joplin got his start there, and today it hosts the Missouri State Fair every August and a Ragtime Festival in June. Eleven locations appear on the National Register of Historic Places. - 4:00 – 6:00 pm Free time! Choose from walking the Katy Trail, revisiting the Depot or downtown Junque shops, poking around the State Fairgrounds, visiting Trade-a-Book used bookshop, visiting the beautiful Sedalia Public Library (the oldest Carnegie library in Missouri), or just chilling out.
- 6:00 pm Dinner at Kehde’s Barbeque. This restaurant is known far and wide as a destination for great BBQ. There is some seating in an old Katy dining car, and service is fast and friendly. 20th and Limit (aka Business Highway 65), right across from the State Fairgrounds. <http://mysedalia.com/kehdes.html>

- Time flexible Breakfast at Katy Trail Café, 108 West 16th Street. Famous for its omelets and popular with people walking and biking on the Katy Trail.
